## More training for warehouse managers

UKWA – the United Kingdom Warehousing Association – has announced that January 2017 will be the start date for its next Warehouse Manager Certificate of Professional Competence (CPC) training programme.

The Association launched its Warehouse Manager CPC in partnership with Logistics Learning Alliance in September 2016. The course consists of two modules, Management of Warehouse Operations and Management of People.

Each programme begins with a one-day workshop. Each module also requires 80 guided learning hours (GLH) – a total of 160 GLH for the qualification – delivered by distance learning.

## Uncertainty continues

The Forklift Truck Market Outlook for 2016, produced by Oxford Economics on behalf of BITA, reveals that member confidence has softened in line with the slowing prospects for the UK economy.

Half of respondents considered themselves 'less optimistic' about the outlook for the coming 12 months, compared to just 20% who said the same back in the spring. This is reflected in attitudes towards expected sales, with fewer respondents now in the 'rise significantly' and 'rise modestly' categories, but opinion is still fairly divided.

Order books are not yet suffering, with most of those polled considering their ledgers to be significantly better than normal, a substantial change from earlier in the year.

All respondents now expect prices to rise, compared to flatter predictions previously.
